- Qualatex Pink Ribbon - 500m Spool (x1)

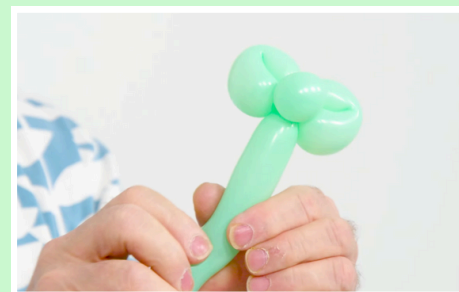
Process



1. Using your 160s, twist five, 5-petal balloon flowers.



2. Take two of your flowers, inflate a green 160 and tie a flower to each end. Repeat this step.



3. To make stems for your Rabbit head foil, perform four small loop twists at the top of a 160. Repeat this step.

Process



4. Place your bunny head foils on top of the stems and tie in using the necks of the foils.



5. Spread the flowers of your daisy bunch and bend the stems up.



6. Place your daisy bunch in your gift bag.



7. Fold your two balloon flower stems in half. Wrap these in your tissue paper like a bouquet and place them in the gift bag.



8. Repeat step 7 with your bunny head foils.



9. Pull the handles of the gift bag together at front of the bag and tie into your last 5-petal balloon flower.



10. Helium-fill your Easter egg foil and using your ribbon, tie this to your frilly weight.



11. Place the frilly weight in the bag.



12. Inflate your daisy foil and using your adhesive, stick this to the back of the bag.
