Process - Surfing Stitch



1. To begin your surfboard take an 11" Strawberry Macaron latex and a clear 260.



2. Fold the clear 260 in half and feed this into the 11" so the neck and the tip of the 260 are coming out of the 11" latex.



3. Inflate your 11" and pinch the neck to keep the air in.

Process - Surfing Stitch



4. Whilst holding the neck of the 11" latex, inflate your 260 until the air reaches around to where you're pinching.



5. Tie off the 260 using the neck and the tip of the 260 balloon.



6. Gently release the air from your 11" latex whilst shaping the 260 into an oblong shape.



7. Place your Stitch foil on the surfboard and using 4 pieces of stretchy balloon tape, stick him down.



8. To attach your surfing Stitch to your stack, tie the excess latex from the 260 inside the surfboard to your desired anchor point.



9. Tie a small duplet using your 5" Azure Satin Luxe and Pastel Blue Satin Luxe latex.



10. Tie this duplet to the rear of the surfboard using the same 260 and adjust the duplet so one balloon is above the other.



11. If the surfboard continues to tip back, add a further 5" latex to help support.



12. Stick the underside of the surfboard down with adhesives to finish.








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Products

- Anagram 5" Blueberry Macaron Latex (x10)
- Anagram 5" Strawberry Macaron Latex (x4)
- Anagram 11" Lemon Macaron Latex (x1)

Process - Moana Flower pt.1



1. Inflate ten 5" Blueberry balloons with two pumps of air each. Tie the knots close to the tip of the neck.



2. Squeeze one of the 5" balloons and twist so you have two bubbles, one smaller than the other.



3. Whilst holding the twist, repeat this with another 5" latex and twist these together to make a petal.







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Process - Moana Flower pt.1



4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 four more times so you have five petals in total.



5. Tie these together using the necks so each petal is tied to the adjacent one to form the flower.



6. Inflate your 11" Lemon latex, size this to the centre of your flower and adjust accordingly. Tie off when you have your desired size.



7. Make a cluster of four with your 5" Strawberry Latex.



8. Tie your 11" Lemon latex to the centre of the cluster using a neck from both the cluster and the 11" latex.



9. Feed your 11" latex through the centre of the flower so the inner balloons of the petal sit between the cluster and the 11" latex.



10. Tie the flower to the stack using a 260.

- Anagram 5" Lemon Macaron Latex (x10)
- Anagram 5" Gold Sateen Satin Latex (x4)
- Anagram 5" Strawberry Macaron Latex (x1)

Process - Moana Flower pt.2



1. Inflate six 5" Lemon latex with three pumps of air each and make three duplets.



2. Squeeze each balloon so they have more of a pear shape.



3. Inflate two 5" Gold Sateen latex with two pumps each.







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Process - Moana Flower pt.2



4. To make an apple twist, take a scrap of a 260 and tie this to the neck of your first 5" Gold latex.



5. Push the neck of the 5" gold latex and the 260 through the balloon so you can feel it on the other side.



6. Grab the knot and twist it. Wrap another scrap of 260 around this knot and tie off.



7. To make the stamen of your flower, take three 5" Strawberry latex and pump a tiny bit of air into them. Tie them off.



8. Tie these 5" Strawberry to the end of a 260 and cut the 260 in half. This will be the stamen.



9. Repeat the same apple twist as before with your second 5" Gold latex but instead of tying a 260 to the neck of the 5" Gold latex, use the stamen you just made to push through the balloon.



10. Tie the two apple twists together and remove any excess 260.



11. Feed your Lemon duplets through the middle of your apple twists one-by-one, and cross each balloon of the duplets over.



12. Stick the flower to a flat part of your stack using your adhesive to finish.
