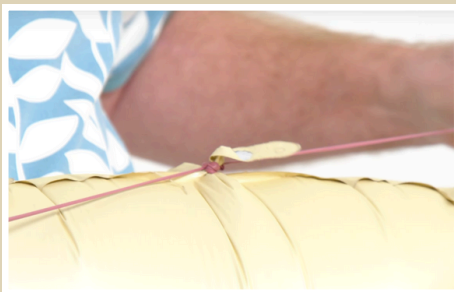

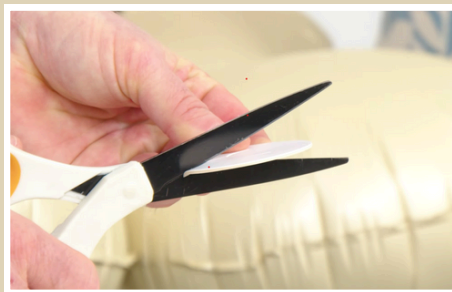

- Grabo **40"** Cream Number 1 Satin Foil
- Grabo **26"** Cream Satin Base Drops Foil
- Grabo **13"** Cream Satin Base Drop Foil
- Natural Cotton Macrame Cord - 4mm x 50m
- Grabo **14"** Boho Butterfly Foil
- Kalisan **260** Retro Rosewood
- Kalisan **260** Standard Clay Pink
- Kalisan **260** Standard Caramel
- Grabo **36"** Boho Rainbow Foil
- Grabo **14"** Boho Rainbow Foil

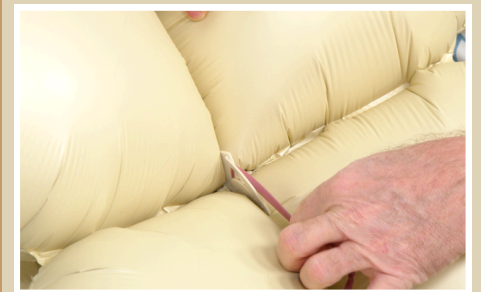
Process



1. Flatten a 260 into a ribbon and tie to the neck of the number foil.



2. Cut a small slit in the edge of the disc provided with the 26" base foil.



3. Feed the 260 through the centre of the base and then the disc, then pull together tightly. Loop the 260 back through the slit you cut in the disc.

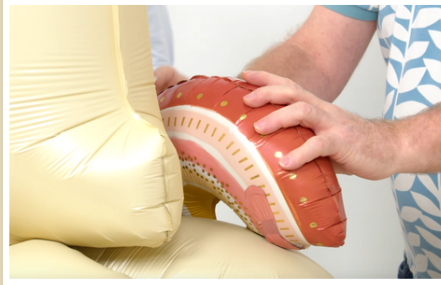

Process



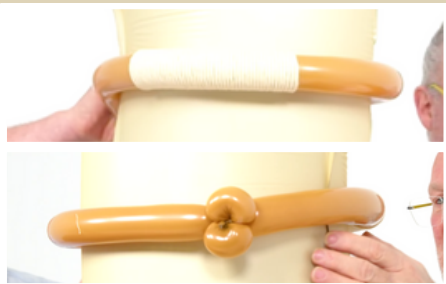
4. Stick one end of the 36" Rainbow foil to the back-right of the larger base and the back of the number foil. Stick the other end to your smaller base.



5. Inflate your 14" Boho Rainbow foil and stick this to the bottom-front of the number foil.



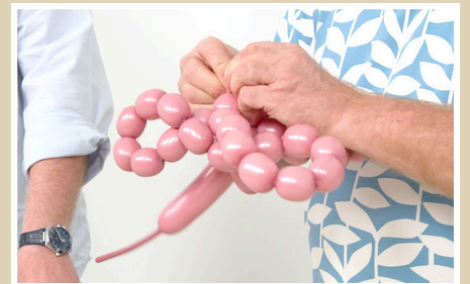
6. Inflate your two 14" Boho Butterflies, stick one to the small base in front of the rainbow and the other to the top of the number foil.



7. Inflate a Standard Caramel 260 and make two pinch twists at the knotted end. With your Macrame cord wound around it and stuck down, wrap the 260 around your number foil and twist the ends together, cutting away any excess latex.



8. Using two Rosewood 260s, take the first, inflate halfway and twist a string of pearls until you reach the end. Loosely twist each end together to stop the pearls from unravelling.



9. With your second Rosewood 260, twist from five to seven pearls and loosely twist each end together. Tie the end of both 260s together.



10. Holding each end of your string of pearls, untwist them from themselves and wrap it around the number foil. Twist the pearls where it is secure, cut away excess latex and tie the ends together.



11. Take your Macrame cord and cut pieces that are a little under two-feet long (61cm). Fold it in half and place an inflated Standard Clay 260 on top, halfway down the cord.



12. Pull the ends of the cord over the 260 and through the loop on the other side. Repeat this with as many lengths of cord as you'd like and when finished, wrap the 260 around the number foil, tying off as you have done the other 260s.
